Parents: RCW 46.61.687 (Effective June 1, 2007) states that a child must be restrained in a child restraint system if the passenger seating position equipped with a safety belt allows sufficient space for installation, until the child is 8 years old or four feet, nine inches or taller. The child restraint system must comply with standards of the United States Department of Transportation (DOT) and must be secured in the vehicle in accordance with instructions of the vehicle manufacturer and the child restraint system manufacturer.

Please provide the proper child restraint system for your child or he/she CANNOT go on the field trip.

Is your child 8 years old or older or 4 ft. 9 in. or taller? Yes No

RCW 46.61.687 states a child who is 8 years old or older OR 4 ft. 9 inches tall or taller shall be properly restrained with the motor vehicles safety belt properly adjusted and fastened around the child/s body OR an appropriately fitting child restraint system. Children under 13 shall be in the back seat position in the vehicle where it is practical to do so.

Can your child ride with an appropriately adjusted safety belt? Yes No
